Guest will be charged the same as members. Registration Free for children below the age of 10 years.

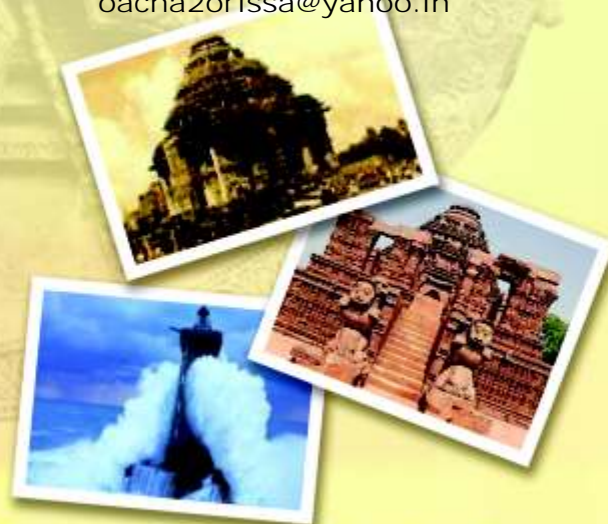
### Last Date of Registration

## "AGAINST ALL ODDS"

Our active addiction had not only made us a loner, but also cagey of trusting people around us. In the early days in NA, recovery came as a gentle surprise to us, after the turmoil of our lives. We struggled to survive against all odds; elements, over whom we thought we had no control. From our streaming tears, upheaval in emotions, creeping fears, self doubt, relentless search for sanity, coming to believe in a HP, surrendering self will, we nervously looked at the wreck that was our life, little realizing that the life unfolding in recovery was full of promise.

In early recovery we thought our HP was testing our determination to stay clean by setting up insurmountable barriers in our recovery journey. We wondered if we had, what it takes to stay clean and after some clean time wondered, if we had what it took to live clean, finally realizing that our continuing trust in a loving HP and his blessings and guidance made our recovery stronger by the day. Our misconceptions of addiction were cleared in NA meetings. By meeting, sharing and helping other addicts, we were able to stay clean.

We made use of the tools that had worked for other recovering addicts who had learned in NA to live without drugs. In embracing our new way of life we were able to take measured steps on the unfamiliar path of recovery and discovered that we had it in us to recover against all odds.

## Venue

OACNA-II will be held in the background of the historic Sun Temple at Konark. The Convention will be held in an open air amphitheatre where the historic monument can be observed in all its majesty. The Sun Temple at Konark is an architectural masterpiece built in the 13<sup>th</sup> century by the Hindu King Narsinghadev of erstwhile Kalinga (Modern day Orissa). It is designated as a World Heritage Site by the United Nations. The accommodation for the convention would be a stones throw from the Convention site.

## How to reach there?

### By Rail

The nearest railway station is located at Puri which is 35 km away from the convention site via the Marine drive. Bhubaneswar is 65 km away from the convention site. Bhubaneswar is very well connected to all important cities in India. Members planning on getting down at Puri or Bhubaneswar are requested to intimate the hospitality committee in advance so that suitable arrangements can be made to ferry them to the convention site from the respective stations.

### By Road

A number of buses operate between Puri and Konark & Bhubaneswar and Konark. Private taxis are plentifully available at reasonable rates from either of the two cities.

### By Air

The nearest Airport is again in Bhubaneswar.

Our hospitality & Hotels sub committee (upon prior information) would be happy to arrange for Airport / Railway pick ups, two and fro from the convention site.

## Registration

The different types of accommodation on offer at the convention are given below:

### Dormitory:

Rs.1200/-, Rs.1300/- and A/c Dorm

Rs.1500/- per person (Limited)

### Rooms:

Rs.1650/- per person .

Three persons per room.

### A/c Rooms:

Rs.2000/- per person.

Three persons per room.

### Non AC Rooms:

Rs.4800/- for Couple.

### AC Rooms:

Rs.6000/- for Couple.

Accommodation can also be arranged at Star hotels in Puri (35 km via marine drive) on prior notice to the Hospitality Chair.

## Weather

Mornings are usually warm (26-28 Degree Celsius) at this time of the year while nights are a bit nippy (16-18 Degree Celsius). Cotton dresses in the daytime and light woolen pullovers in the night time are advisable. Members are requested to come prepared with blankets.
